Medical grants are only paid to Kaumatua 60 years of age and over per treatment category per year

- \$200 - Eye treatment (glasses)
- \$200 - Dental treatment (false teeth)
- \$200 - Hearing Treatment (hearing aid)
- \$800 – Specialist (surgery)
- \$50 -Travel (doctors appointment, one per year)

MEDICAL GRANTS made by the Trust Board come from the Board's half share of Lake Taupo fishing license sales, in accordance with the Maori Land Amendment and Maori Land Claims Amendment Act 1926, and the Maori Trust Boards Act 1955. For a person to be eligible for a grant, he/she must be the NATURAL ISSUE of an ORIGINAL OWNER of the Ngati Tuwharetoa blocks of land adjoining Lake Taupo and its tributaries prior to 1926 when the titles of the bed of the lake and tributaries passed in to Crown ownership.

The following categories of persons are NOT ELIGIBLE for the Board's grants:

1. A person who purchased an interest in land adjoining Lake Taupo or its tributary rivers and streams, either before 1926 or after this date and who is not an original owner or the natural issue of an original owner.
2. A person who obtained an interest in land adjoining Lake Taupo or its tributary rivers and streams by way of a gift of that land or a legacy from a Will and who is not an original owner or the natural issue of an original owner.
3. An adopted person who is not an original owner or the natural issue of an original owner.

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
